

The Main Campus at Elkins Mountain Schools is a Level III residential facility for male youth experiencing highly challenging behavioral and emotional issues that have the potential to adversely affect their adult lives. The program is highly structured and heavily staffed. The campus is located in the mountains of eastern West Virginia.

Youth enrolled at the Main Campus are provided with an array of counseling services to determine and meet their unique needs. They attend classes in an on-grounds school provided by the West Virginia Department of Education. The school provides opportunities for vocational and lifeskills training. Health services are also available on-site. Youth enrolled at the Main Campus also participate in a variety of recreational and social activities including organized sports, community service, hiking, camping and fishing.

The program is designed to initiate a turning point in a child's life. It is a temporary stop to readjust attitudes and goals before returning to their families.

TREATMENT

- Individualized Treatment Plan (Guardians, JPO, Parents, Attorneys, Physician and EMS staff are key members of the Treatment Team.)
- Individual and/or group counseling, individual group therapy and family therapy.
- Behavior Management Implementation
- Diagnostic Interview by a Psychiatrist
- Psychotropic Medication Review by a Psychiatrist
- Adaptive Behavior Services
- Recreational Opportunities
- Crisis Intervention
- Clinical Evaluation
- On-grounds school provided by the WV Department of Education
- Health Services



ELIGIBILITY

A highly structured and intensively staffed group setting for youth with a DSM-IV diagnosis that results in severe disturbance in conduct and emotions leading to impairment across multiple life domains.

- Must be male
- Resident of West Virginia
- Child must be in the custody of DHHR
- Ages 13-17
- IQ \geq 70

REFERRAL INFORMATION:

- Social Summary
- Placement History
- Medical History
- Current Psychological (within the last year)
- School Records (IEP, Behavior Reports, Current Report Card, etc.)
- Current Court order showing status of custody
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Social Security Card
- Copy of Immunization Record

Once the completed packet is received, an interview will be scheduled. Parents, guardians and social workers are encouraged to participate in the interview process.
