



The Oak Ridge Campus of Elkins Mountain Schools is a Level II residential facility, providing a structured setting for male youth experiencing moderate to severe challenges at school, at home and in the community. This campus is located in the rural, mountainous Tygart Valley of eastern West Virginia.

Youth enrolled at the Oak Ridge campus are provided with an array of counseling services to determine and meet their unique needs. They attend classes in an on-grounds school provided by the West Virginia Department of Education. Health services are also available on-site. Youth enrolled at the Oak Ridge campus also participate in a variety of recreational and social activities including organized sports, community service, hiking, camping and fishing. The program is designed to initiate a turning point in a child's life. It is a temporary stop to readjust attitudes and goals before returning to families.

TREATMENT

- Individualized Treatment Plan (Guardians, JPO, Parents, Attorneys, Physician and EMS staff are key members of the Treatment Team.)
- Individual and/or group counseling, individual group therapy and family therapy.
- Behavior Management Implementation
- Diagnostic Interview by a Psychiatrist
- Psychotropic Medication Review by a Psychiatrist
- Adaptive Behavior Services
- Recreational Opportunities
- Crisis Intervention
- Clinical Evaluation
- On-grounds school provided by the WV Department of Education
- Health Services

ELIGIBILITY

A structured group setting for youth with a DSM-IV diagnosis that results in moderate to severe problems in school, home and/or the community.

- Male
- Resident of West Virginia
- Child must be in the custody of DHHR
- Ages 13-17
- IQ>70

- Placement History
- Medical History
- Current Psychological (within the last year)
- School Records (IEP, Behavior Reports, Current Report Card)
- Current Court order showing custody status
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Copy of Social Security Card

Once the completed packet is received, then an interview will be scheduled. Parents, guardians and social workers are encouraged to participate.
